Emergency Support Pack

Emergency numbers, embassy contacts, exploitation support and worker safety checklist.

Use this first

This guide is designed to help migrant workers understand practical next steps in Romania. Rules and processes can change, so always check official sources or get qualified advice for your own case.

Use 112 for immediate danger

In Romania, 112 is the emergency number for police, ambulance and fire. Use it if there is immediate danger or urgent emergency.

Emergency evidence checklist

[]	Take screenshots of threatening messages.
[]	Write down dates, times, names and locations.
[]	Save payslips, contract and bank records.
[]	Copy passport/residency documents to a safe place.
[]	Tell a trusted person where you are.
[]	Contact embassy/official support if appropriate.

Important warning

Your passport is your identity document. If someone is holding it against your will, document what happened and seek support immediately.

If salary is unpaid

- Keep payslips and bank evidence.

- Ask for written clarification.
- Record dates and hours.
- Check official labour support routes.
