Housing & Address Checklist

Rental documents, proof of address, registration guidance and tenant red flags.

Use this first

This guide is designed to help migrant workers understand practical next steps in Romania. Rules and processes can change, so always check official sources or get qualified advice for your own case.

Housing documents to keep

☐	Rental agreement or accommodation document.
☐	Landlord/contact information.
☐	Proof of payments or rent receipts.
☐	Photos of room/property condition.
☐	Utility payment evidence if relevant.
☐	Address document used for residency, if applicable.

Red flags

- No written agreement.
- Large unexplained deductions from salary.
- Overcrowded or unsafe accommodation.
- Threats linked to housing if you ask about wages or rights.
- No access to your own documents.

Before signing or moving in

☐	Ask what is included in rent.
☐	Confirm deposit amount and return conditions.
☐	Take photos before moving in.
☐	Keep written messages.
☐	Do not rely only on verbal promises.
