Before you travel

Travel rules depend on nationality, residence document, destination and current Schengen rules. Always check official guidance before travel.

Carry and check

[]	Passport.
[]	Romanian residency card/permit if applicable.
[]	Travel tickets and accommodation details.
[]	Health/travel insurance where needed.
[]	Employer or purpose-of-travel documents if relevant.
[]	Emergency contacts and embassy details.

Common mistakes

- Assuming residency automatically allows unlimited travel.
- Travelling with expired or damaged documents.
- Ignoring entry/exit day limits.
- Not checking destination-specific rules.
